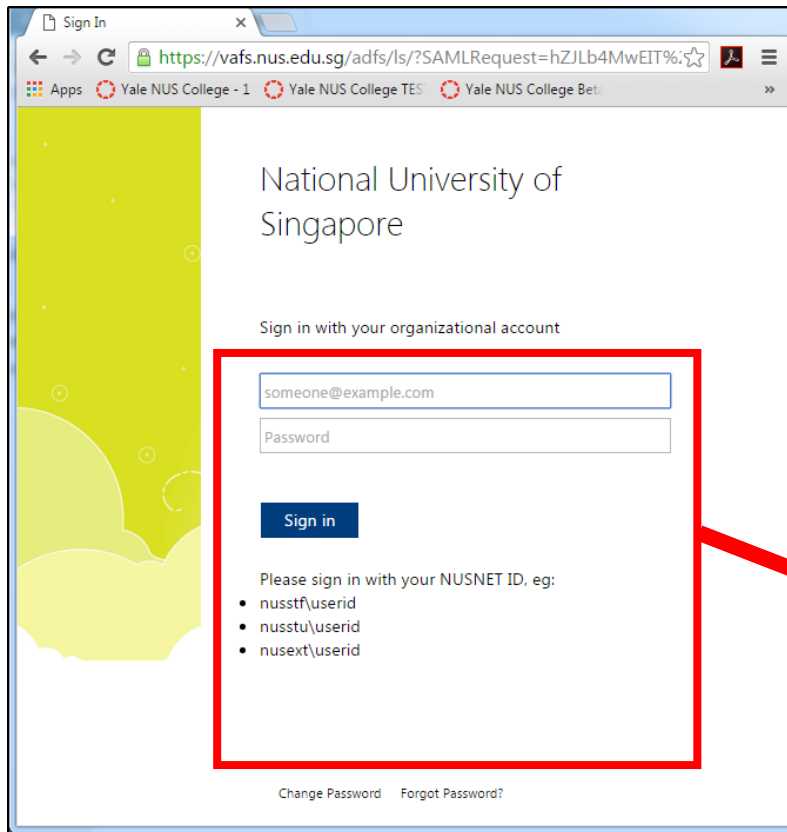


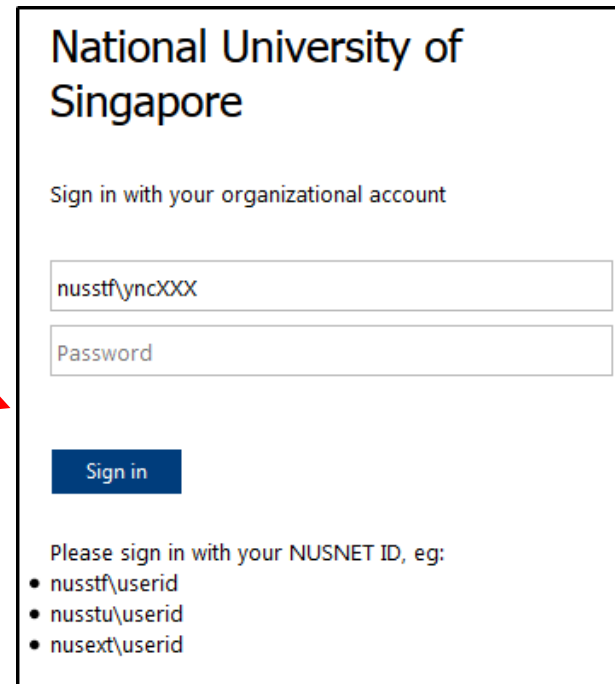
How to view & print Course Evaluations report
